

Sigma Tau Delta Meeting Minutes for March 18, 2007

Meeting started at 2:07 p.m.

Members Present: Kim Lock, Jessica Upson, and Bridgett VanDerwalker. Dr. Tom Hillard was also present.

Minutes were approved for January 21st, 2007 meeting.

1. Fundraiser

Because we have raised so much money this year we will not hold a yard sale this spring.

2. Social Events

At least \$1,100 of our current funds will be for a service project to buy furniture for Middleton High School's Library.
