The meeting was called to order at 1:05 p.m.

**1. FUNDRAISERS**

The following ideas were discussed:

**Bake sale.** Kelly suggested a bake sale possibly combined with a poetry reading. Issues: would have to get permission from Aramark about selling food if held on campus. Also would need to ask about reserving a place to sell goods. We decided that we would combine a bake sale with the yard sale we'll have next March. We will ask members and faculty to help bake goods to sell.

**Yard sale.** Previous STD yard sales have met with varying success. Quality goods are key to a successful yard sale. Getting members, faculty, and others to contribute is very important. We will hold a yard sale at the beginning of March. Location: North End due to high traffic: maybe Jessica Upson's or Terry Allen's house. We will need to send an email to faculty and members asking them to donate, and put out a newspaper ad in the Statesmen. **Jessica will organize the sale.**

**Raffle.** Maybe a silent auction? Prizes could include services, a Valentine gift basket, and other items. Would like to try to get donations if possible for raffle items. Would need to ask permission from the BSU Foundation at least a month ahead of the event. Tickets must be reasonably priced for college students. We would send out emails to STD members and faculty asking for gift donations. **Kelly will organize the raffle.**

**Cook book.** A Literary-theme cookbook was discussed, but no action taken at this time.

**Academic Decathlon.** We will need plenty of judges. **Kim will inform members of the time and location of the decathlons.**

Note: ABSU matches 2 for 1 any dollars we raise.

**2. SOCIAL EVENTS**

Open to all STD members. We will pay part of the costs.

**Plays.** We decided on “American History Abridged” playing in January, Rated PG-13, possibly in conjunction with dinner somewhere. **Kim will find out group rates and we will decide on the exact date.** Officers will choose a restaurant if we go to dinner.

**Movie.** Sunday lunch and matinee show at the Flicks. When: 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of December. **Kim will ask Carol Skinner, owner of The Flicks, if we can charge the costs to the ASBSU credit card.** Kim will send an email to members and have them RSVP and pay \$5.00 for lunch, drink, and a movie ticket. Receipts submitted to ASBSU must show no alcoholic drinks.

**Painting Activity.** Kim knows a local artist, Miriam Woito, who hosts painting classes tailored to suit group needs. The emphasis would be on having fun and letting go of inhibitions about doing something artistic. How much interest do members have in doing something creative other than writing? No action at this time.
